

## **How To Add The International Wallpapers To The Default Wallpapers That Come With Windows 7, So That You Can Have One Huge “Desktop Slide Show”**

**Problem:** You must have completed my document called “How To Use Hidden International Wall Paper And Themes” first!! If you want to take all of the International Wallpapers and add them to the Default Wallpapers that come with Windows 7, so that you can have one huge Desktop Slide Show. You will need to follow the steps below.

### **Solution:**

- 1) Open up “My Computer” and go to “C:\Windows\Globalization\MCT”
- 2) Double-click on the “MCT” folder, and you should see MCT-AU, MCT-CA, MCT-GB, MCT-US, and MCT-ZA.
- 3) Double-click on “MCT-AU” and then double-click on “Australia”
- 4) Highlight and copy all the “.jpgs” in this folder.
- 5) Now minimize that window and go back to “My Computer” and go to “C:\Users\Public\Pictures\Sample Pictures”
- 6) Right-Click and go to “Paste” This should past the “Australia” pictures into this folder.
- 7) Now go back to “C:\Windows\Globalization\MCT” Double-click on the “MCT” folder and repeat steps “1-6” with the remaining folders (MCT-CA, MCT-GB, MCT-ZA, and MCT-US).
- 8) Once you have done that close all windows until you are back at your desktop.
- 9) Right-click on your desktop and go to “Personalize”.
- 10) At the bottom, click on “Desktop Background”.
- 11) At the top beside “Picture Location” click on the drop down and select “Pictures Library”.
- 12) You should see all of the pictures you just copied. You will need to put a check mark in the box (In the top left-hand corner of each picture) that you want to be included in the

“Slide Show”. If you want all of the pictures then go to the top right-hand corner and click on the button that says “Select All”.

- 13) Now under “Picture Position”, “Change Picture Every”, “Shuffle”, and “When Using Battery Power, Pause The Slide Show To Save Power” pick the necessary options that you want for your “Slide Show”.
- 14) After you do that go to the bottom right-hand side of this window and click on “Save Changes”.
- 15) Now close out of “Control Panel” and your “Slide Show” will start. Enjoy!!
