

## **Display A Devices Battery Report Windows 8 & 8.1.**

- 1) From the “Desktop View” you will need to move your mouse to the top right-hand corner of the screen to display the “Search” Charm, and then click on it.
- 2) Now type in the words cmd and then right-click on cmd.exe and select “Run As Administrator”.
- 3) When the Command Prompt opens type in cd \ and press enter (That is cd space \).
- 4) Now type in the command powercfg /batteryreport (That is powercfg space /batteryreport) and hit “Enter”.
- 5) You should now see something like “Battery Life Report Saved To C:\battery-report.html”
- 6) Now go to C:\ and then double-click on the file called “battery-report.html”.
- 7) You should now see a lot of information about your batteries whole life. ☺
