## Every Time I Right-Click The Start Button I Am Only Given The Option For PowerShell. Where Did The Command Prompt Go?

- 1) From the "Desktop View" in Windows 8.1 you will need to right-click on the task bar and then select "Properties".
- 2) You will then see the "Taskbar and Navigation Properties" dialog box. Click on the "Navigation Tab".
- 3) Now look under the "Corner Navigation" section and you will need to remove the check mark in the box beside "Replace Command Prompt with Windows PowerShell in the menu when I right-click the lower-left corner or press Windows key+x".
- 4) The Click on Apply and Ok, and when you right-click on the Start Button you will see the Command Prompt and not PowerShell.
